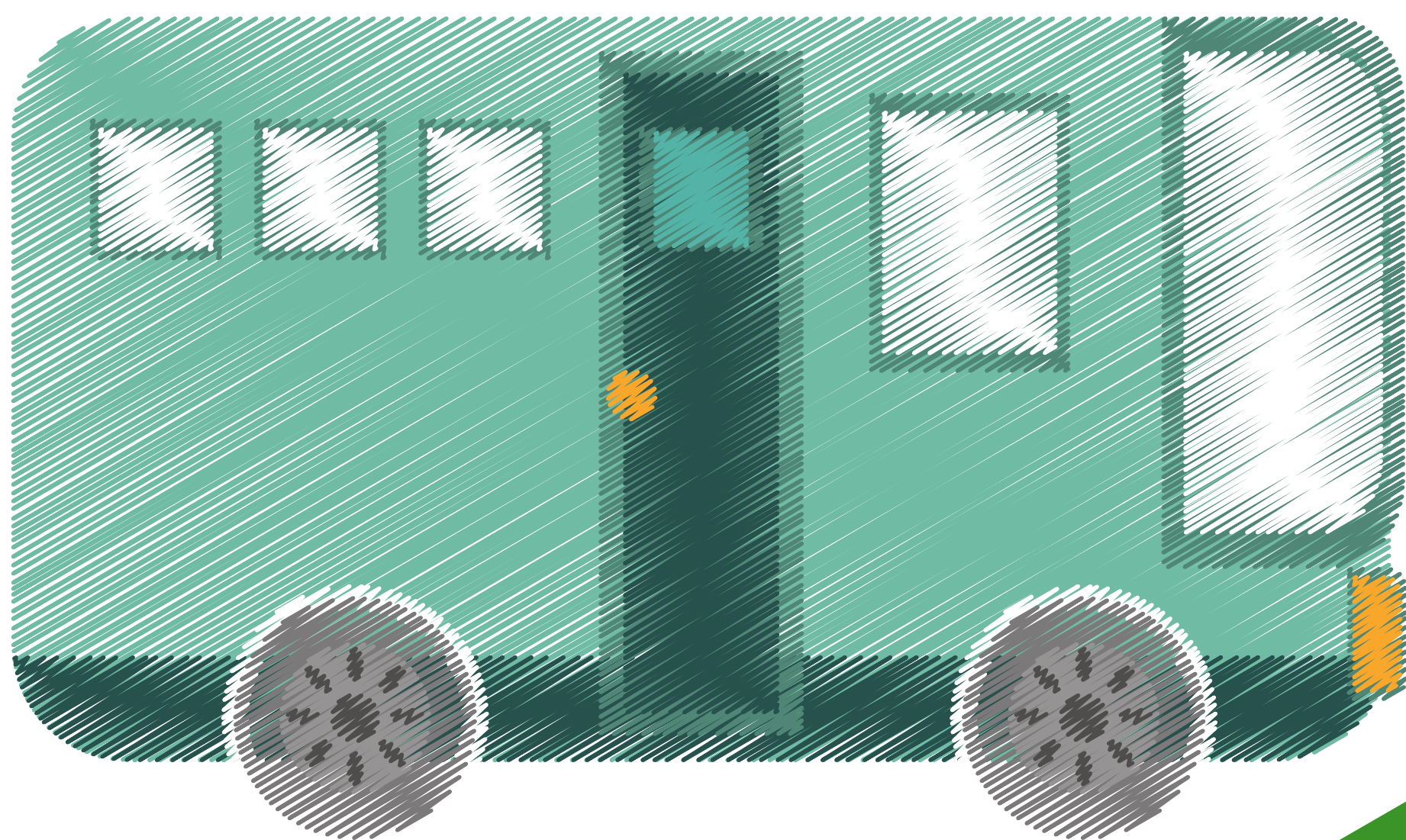

Rail cards?

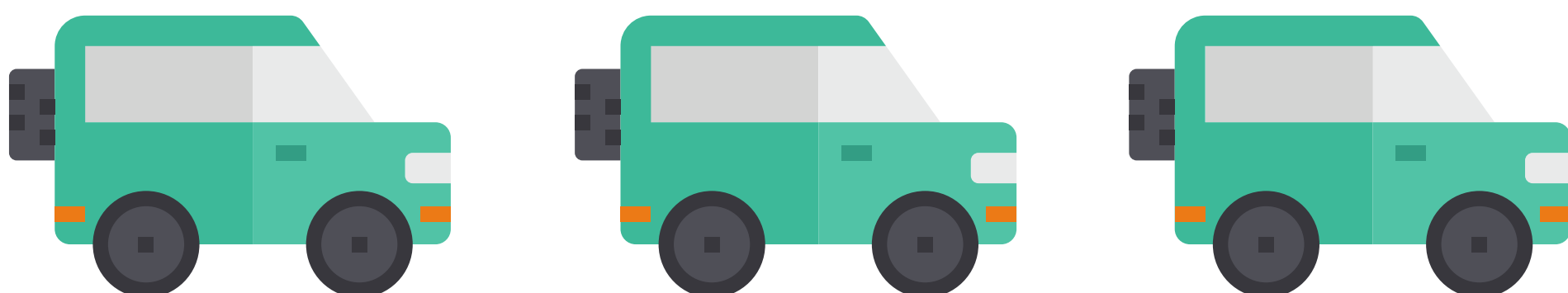
Train passes?
